WORKING SESSIONS REPORT JULY to SEPTEMBER 2021

In July only five members turned out, perhaps because of the forecasted rain. We replaced a step that had rotted near the viewpoint on Alexandrina Plantation. On Sandy Lane Reserve three paths at the Heather Rise end were cleared of overhanging bramble and other vegetation. A couple of small trees that had collapsed were also cut down and cleared.

August saw a great turnout of thirteen members on a sunny morning. We cleared all the minor paths on Alexandrina Plantation, some of which had become completely impassable. The pavement area on Thoresby Road along the edge of our reserve was also cleared of overhanging bramble.

In September we had seven members. That morning we cut down overhanging bramble on the bridle path and this was also swept to clear leaf litter and tree debris. Two paths on the Markham Road reserve were also cleared of bramble and nettles.

On all occasions the usual litter pick on both reserves was completed
