

FRIENDS OF BRAMCOTE RIDGE

WORKING SESSIONS REPORT JULY to NOVEMBER 2023

In July we had 6 members turning out. They concentrated on the Alexandrina Plantation paths including the one leading down from Walter's Seat which had become overgrown with broom and some gorse. Brambles overhanging other paths were also cleared and mugwort was removed from the Thoresby Road wildflower area.

For the August session we had 10 members volunteering. The Green Flag Community Award notices for 2022/23 were taken down so that they could be updated. The rest of the group worked on the Sandy Lane Open Space reserve clearing pathways, especially those in Ivy Wood where a collapsed tree was removed.

September saw only 5 volunteers attending. The new Green Flag Community Award notices for 2023/24 were erected. Again overhanging branches, bramble etc were removed from the main paths and broom was cleared from around a nice patch of heathers that are establishing themselves on the grassland area near Jasmine Close.

In October we had 7 members who cleared the bridle path where soil and tree debris had accumulated following the very heavy rain we had had in the previous week. The main paths on Alexandrina Plantation were all checked for overhanging branches which were removed to make the paths safe.



Finally in November 6 members came to work. Eighteen beech saplings were planted in the gaps in the hedge alongside the main path / grassland area and much of the vegetation growing into the hedge was removed. Pruning was carried out along the path leading down to Heather Rise.

As always litter was collected from both reserves on all four sessions.
