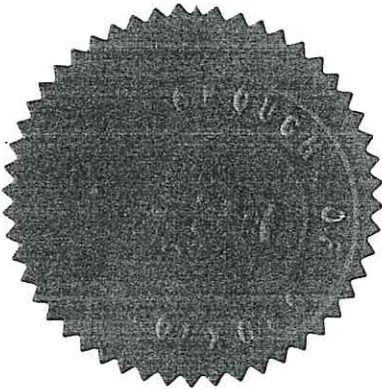


National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949

In pursuance of Sections 19 and 21 of the above-mentioned Act, and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, the Broxtowe Borough Council hereby declares that the land containing 5 hectares or thereabouts situated in the Parish of Beeston North in the County of Nottinghamshire and shown edged red on the attached plan is owned by the Council.

AND in pursuance of Sections 19(2) and 21(4) of the above-mentioned Act and all other powers aforesaid the Council hereby further declares that the said land is being managed as a Nature Reserve.

This declaration may be referred to as the Sandy Lane Open Space Local Nature Reserve Declaration 2005.

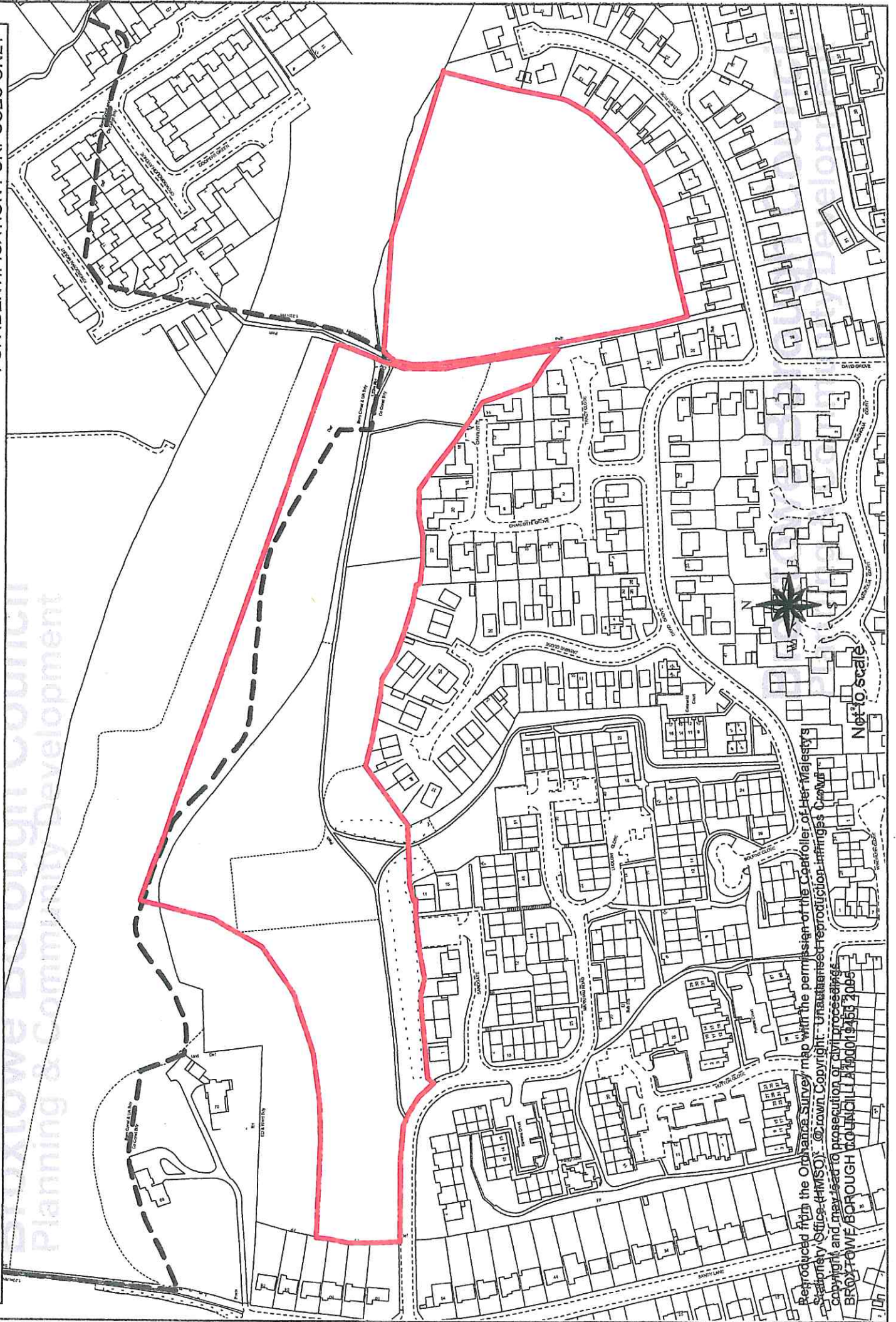
